



## SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS – 2025

The State Government and the Department of Education & Training permit the school to seek payment of Voluntary Contributions and Charges for each student enrolled at the school. <p><b>CHARGES FOR OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR:</b></p> <p>Charges apply for the provision of extra cost optional activities that are part of an education program and which 'contributions' do not cover. All activities outlined below are optional and if no payment is received, an alternative educational activity will be provided for your child.</p> <p>All 2025 extra cost optional activities have been approved by the School Board. The estimated costs provided are set as an upper limit and will not exceed the amount shown. If a particular event does not transpire within the school year, no charges for that event will apply.</p> <p><i>Payment of the following charges is not required at the time of finalising payment of contributions. Where staff arrange extra cost optional activities, payment will be requested immediately prior to the activity.</i></p>	<p>Collected throughout the year as events happen</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Incursions (K-6)</b> <b>MAXIMUM COST PER STUDENT</b> The maximum annual cost will be \$50.00 per student, but is likely to be less depending on the actual cost of each activity.</li> </ul>	<p><b>\$50.00</b></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Excursions (K-6)</b> <b>MAXIMUM COST PER STUDENT</b> The School Board recognises the value of excursions for students and seeks to support teachers who coordinate them as part of their teaching programs. Up to 2 excursions per term per class may occur. Excursions for the purposes of this document are defined as outings that do not include an overnight stay.</li> </ul>	<p><b>\$70.00</b></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Camps</b> <b>MAXIMUM COST PER STUDENT</b> The maximum charge for Year 6 camp is \$400.00 per student. Parents can start making instalments in term 4, 2024.</li> </ul>	<p><b>\$400.00</b></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>PEAC</b> <b>MAXIMUM COST PER STUDENT</b> Years 4 to 6</li> </ul>	<p><b>\$50.00</b></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Swimming, In Term Swimming (P-6)</b> <b>MAXIMUM COST PER STUDENT</b> Selected Year groups may be involved in swimming lessons. These will usually be in a 10 lesson block. Cost will cover entrance to the pool and bus transport.</li> </ul>	<p><b>\$60.00</b></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Inter-school Competitions</b> <b>MAXIMUM COST PER STUDENT</b> Some students may be given the opportunity to participate in inter-school competitions including athletics, cross-country running, academic competitions etc. Travel and bus costs are all inclusive.</li> </ul>	<p><b>\$30.00</b></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Instrumental Music (Years 5 &amp; 6)</b> <b>MAXIMUM COST PER STUDENT</b> The school offers Instrumental studies for students in Year 5 and 6</li> </ul>	<p><b>\$120.00</b></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Year 6 Graduation</b> Covers cost of Year 6 Jumpers, Graduation Lunch and Year book.</li> </ul>	<p><b>\$70.00</b></p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Band</b> Cost of Shirt for Choir members</li> </ul>	<p><b>\$40.00</b></p>
